

Directions to Round House Lodge

From Albuquerque take I-25 South 74 miles to Socorro. Take exit 150. Go through town and turn right onto US-60 Spring Street to Magdalena. Follow US-60 West 105 miles through Magdalena and Datil to Quemado. Go through Quemado and turn left onto NM Hway 32. Go 30 miles and take a left at Mile Marker 11. Follow the dirt road 2 miles. You will pass two houses on your left and one house on your right. The road will bend back to the North (your left). At the top of the hill you will go through a cattle guard. At the cattle guard, there will be a wooded NH RANCH sign. Turn right at the sign, over another cattle guard (do not go to the log cabin at your right or the house with the big red barn). Follow the dirt road through a gate and a creek and it will bring you up to the lodge.

Artesia Municipal Airport covers an area of 1,440 acres at an elevation of 3,541 feet above sea level. It has two runways with asphalt surfaces: 3/21 is 6,301 by 150 feet and 12/30 is 5,390 by 150 feet

For the 12-month period ending April 6, 2011, the airport had 11,550 general aviation aircraft operations, an average of 31 per day. At that time there were 27 aircraft based at this airport: 74% single-engine, 19% multi-engine, and 7% jet

From Albuquerque, take I25 south for about 85 miles

then take US 380 East towards San Antonio/Carrizozo

**From US 380, between Tinnie and Roswell take Picacho Road South up the
canyon until you top out**

Take a right on Skeen Road, and travel until Joyce Road

Take a right and travel until the barn

Take the left fork prior to the barn and follow to camp

Landovazo

Directions to Unit 12 Ranch

From Albuquerque :

Go West on I-40 to the 117 (just prior to Grants)

Take the 117 to 36 and on into Fence Lake

At Fence Lake take a Right

Approximately 6 miles North of Fence Lake on 36 there will be a large metal archway with a sign that says: "Rancho Landovazo". (that's where you will be met)

Rainy Mesa Ranch

As you come into Reserve on Hwy 12 continue through Main Street heading south. It will turn into #435.

You will cross the river and begin to climb into the forest. 435 turns into forest road 141. The road is paved but is very dilapidated with potholes. Travel slow. The pavement goes roughly for 25 miles and then turns into gravel. There will be many side roads, but stay on the main road.

You will turn onto County Road 019 or C019. This is the first left after mile marker 21.

You will travel 4.5 miles north to a double swinging gate at the top of a canyon. Go through it and close it behind you. You will descent into the canyon and at the bottom turn Left. If the gate is closed, the combo is 1977. Close it behind you. Cross the creek and go down stream to the fork in the road, stay right, then stay left. This takes you up on the ridge. We are in the cabin with the corral attached to it.

Florida Mountains

Directions to Florida Mountains

From Deming, take Highway 11 south towards Columbus. Turn left on Camino Doce.

Go approx. 10 miles east towards mountains to fork in road. Stay right until green gate, go thru

Gate to the Windmill, camp is located there.
